









Public Transport Policy How do the major parties compare?

Network Capacity:

The Greens support high capacity signalling to increase network capacity - quickly and relatively cheaply. They support Metro tunnel to meet future capacity needs

The ALP will fund \$3billion for initial stages of Metro Rail tunnel. Metro tunnel will increase network capacity on some lines. It is likely to take around 10yrs to build.

The Coalition is committed to NOT funding public transport.

New Rail Lines:

The Greens support new lines to Doncaster, Rowville, and the airport.

The ALP has committed funds to the Metro tunnel before any new lines.

The Coalition is committed to NOT funding public transport.

Car Dependency:

The Greens support public transport expansion that provides everyone in Melbourne with an opportunity to leave their car at home.

The ALP has not ruled out prioritising roads over public transport.

The Coalition is committed to NOT funding public transport. They are committed to having Victorians face an \$8billion debt risk for 6kms of toll road.
